

68: fully cool crossword

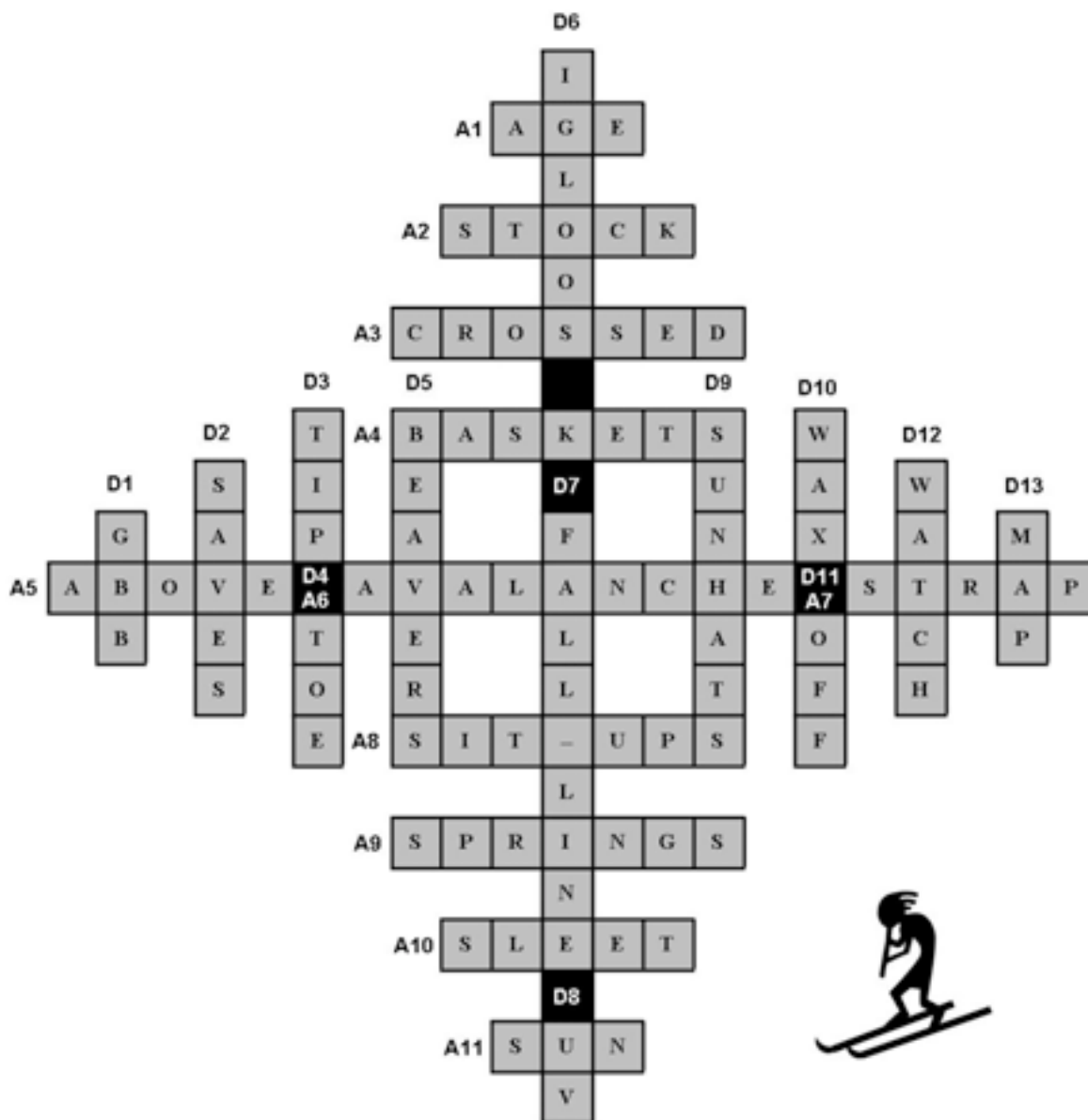
Code Red Alert!!

 - c) copy the wordsearch answer sheet and black out the random letters (creating a crossword answer sheet)
 - d) copy this crossword answer sheet, write clues, delete the remaining letters, add some numbers (thereby creating a crossword).
